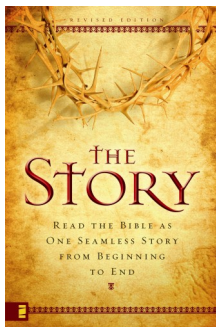
Small Groups for *The Story*

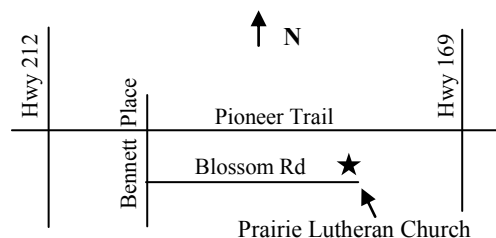

Listen to our youth share life-changing experiences from summer mission trips.



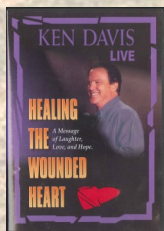
9.25 Artist Paul Oman

Dr. Mark Throntveit, Professor of Old Testament at Luther Seminary will lead us through a study of God's plan as outlined in Genesis.

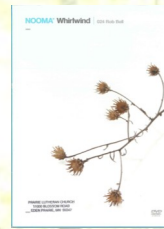


11.13 Moses

A special presentation from our Men's Ministry team.

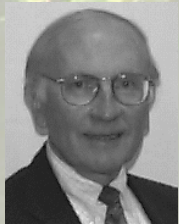


11.27 Nooma: Whirlwind
