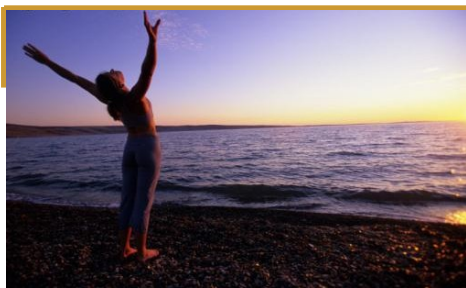


The death of a loved one is a loss to family and friends alike. The greatest consolation to survivors is the promise of Jesus. By his death and resurrection we have the hope of eternal life.

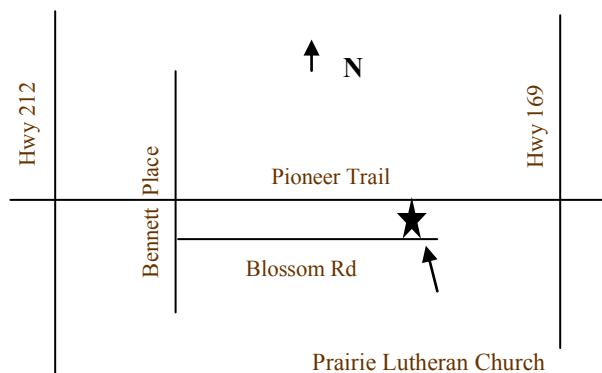

The family may contact the mortuary first or contact the church office, at 952.829.0525.

We are available to assist in arranging for special music including a pianist and a soloist. Other instrumentalists are available upon request. Refreshments following the service are also an option.
